Antonio Varsori

is full professor of history of international relations at the Department of Political Science, Law and International Studies of the University of Padova. He has been head of department (2012-2015) and he is currently a member of the Academic Senate. He is the chairman of the liaison committee of historians of contemporary Europe, member of the Committee for the publication of the Italian Diplomatic Documents at the Italian Foreign Ministry and member of the Academic Council of the ESA History Project. He has been the first President of the Italian Society of International History (SISI) and currently member of the steering committee. He is the editor of the journal "Ventunesimo Secolo" and member of the editorial board/scientific comittee of the "Journal of European Integration History" and "Cold War History". He is the editor of the SIEC series of the Franco Angeli publishing house and co-editor with E. Bussière and M. Dumoulin of the Euroclio series of the Peter Lang publishing house. He wrote extensively on the Cold War, the European integration, Italy's foreign policy and Britain's foreign policy.
